



CHR & Rhythmic CHR – July PPM

Noteworthy highlight, of course, is the fact that the beginning of this survey coincided with Michael Jackson's passing. Especially in light of the contemporary nature of these formats, that's something that should be taken into strong consideration. A 1.0 share (6+) in an applicable PPM-measured July 2009 survey was required to appear in these CHR and Rhythmic CHR summaries. Dual asterisks (**) designate non-metro stations.

AQH Share

This is the seventh successive month that **WXKS-FM/Boston ("Kiss")** scores the strongest 6+ numbers among CHR's in PPM-based markets and with a +.5, the **Clear Channel** station breaks a string of four successive down months.
